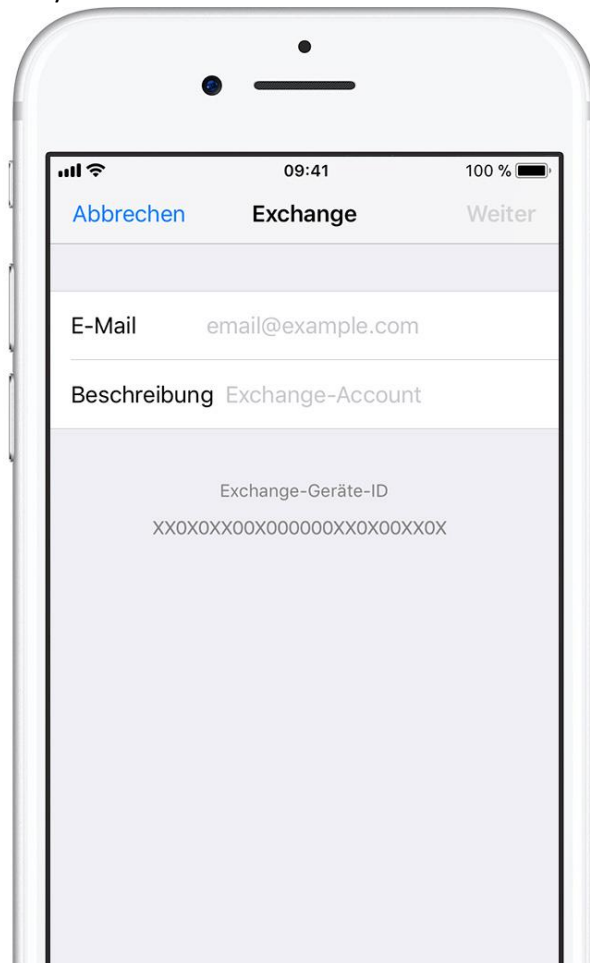


Setting Up Exchange ActiveSync on iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch

1. Add an Exchange account. Press on "Settings" > "Accounts & Passwords" > "Add Account" > "Exchange".
2. Enter your e-mail address. You can also enter a description for the account.



3. connect to the Exchange server. After you have entered your e-mail address, you can either select "Configure manually" or "Log in" to connect to your Exchange server.

If you select "Configure manually", you can set up an Exchange account with default authentication. Enter your e-mail password. You may be asked to enter additional server information.

If you select "Login", your e-mail address will be sent to Microsoft to determine the data for your Exchange account.



4. synchronize content. You can synchronize mail, contacts, calendars, reminders and notes. When you are finished, press "Save".



Edit Exchange settings

Press "Settings" > "Accounts & Passwords" and select your Exchange account. You can also set up automatic absence messages and change the synchronization interval for mail. You can also tap the name of your account to make advanced settings, such as SSL and S/MIME.
